Allscripts Sunrise(TM) Helps Earn Highest Level of Electronic Medical Record (EMR) Adoption

There are eight stages (0-7) in the HIMSS Analytics EMR Adoption Model, and Stage 7 represents the most advanced patient record environment. Currently, only 6.2% of hospitals in the HIMSS Analytics® Database have currently reached Stage 7.
